 - D. Continuing students: How has the scholarship helped you in college?
2. Attach at least one letter of recommendation. Letters may be from teachers, counselors, supervisors, church leaders, coaches or other adults (besides family members) that know you well. You may submit letters that you have used for other college or scholarship applications.
3. Attach a transcript or have the school you are attending provide a copy of your transcript to the address below.
